Norms of the Church for Lenten Penance

FAST - Good Friday is a day of fast. On days of fast, one full meal and two lesser meals are allowed. Eating between meals is not permitted.

Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are bound to fast.

ABSTINENCE - The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. On days of abstinence, meat may not be taken. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years of age or older. If members of the Faithful are unable to observe the fast and abstinence regulations because of ill health or other reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of
